[Report by 2021 Treasurer Rich Barry]: The final report of 2021 is complete. Please note that not all 2021 money made it into the accounts before new years eve. So categories such as social, off-road, and rally will see 2021 money reported in the January 2022 report.

- We reimbursed Peter for expenses from the successful off-road event in November.

Autocross: [Grant Lenahan]

Last year we had an abbreviated season with 4 planned events and three actual, all at Pocono. We had to cancel the last event due to lack of signup, mostly attributed to weather and the lateness of the date. We will therefore not repeat any late October events. Our goal for his year is NOT settled. We recently reviewed dates and goals and sent our requests to Pocono. Some of the dates are solid, others we are awaiting a reply. So we may need to plan for some contingencies.

This year we hope to have \sim 5 events, again all at Pocono. The CCC remains an open issue with Covid re-surging. Our tentative schedule is as follows:

May 7th (Saturday) - coincident with RTR's large Pocono event including DE

June 19 (Sunday) - this could dovetail with Parade

Possible event the day before Parade (at Pocono) this year likely June 11th (no confirmation)

Looking for one or two more dates in July or early August or early September - we need to avoid conflicts with DE, especially WGI-1.

I don't know what Pocono can give us today.

I am investigating sponsorship again this year. Flemington did not come through last year, but it was a very unusual year.

We also plan to replace some of the more repair -intensive old equipment including our 20-25 year old displays with ones that are new, and have integrated wifi. This ought to speed setup and eliminate many timing issues that have plagued us. When I repaired one of our displays parts were no longer available and RaceAmerica didnt even know such old -re-production units existed in the field. No wonder I was spending a lot of time on them.

- Unfortunately, after posting twenty-plus new member signups for nine of the first ten months of 2021, November and December achieved lackluster enrollments of only 16 and 12 for November and December, respectively.
- This year did not achieve the typical Christmas gift membership "bump" we've witnessed in prior years.
- January will be a good indicator of whether there is latent demand or if this is the start of a longer-term trend.



The table and bar graph below summarizes new members by month for 2016-2021:





Overall Membership


Seven consecutive months of twenty-plus new member enrollments pushed total Primary memberships as of January 1, 2022, remained steady at 2,366. Combine that with

1,369 family and one life member, and NNJR's total membership currently remains steady at 3,736.

The three graphs below highlight the Total, Primary, and Associate Member trends dating back to June 2015. Note how the green graph continues to show a slow, steadily increasing trend.







Transfers

NNJR experienced two transfers in and five out, for a net loss of (3) primary members in December. For all of 2021, transfers in totaled 22 while transfers out was (72) for a net loss of (50) as geographic moves continue to be the primary driver of this outflow.

Spend vs. Budget

Our 2021 **TENTATIVE** (shaded green) cash flows are based upon our approved budget for 2021. We are double-checking our numbers for the year, but if these hold true our total spend will be favorable to our budget for the following reasons:

- The actual 2021 new membership of 255 was only five people higher than our conservative plan of 250 for the year.
- The take rate of T-shirts was lower in the back half of 2021 than expected.
- We did not purchase door prizes for the October new member gathering.
- We did not actively promote the proposed dealer incentive originally budgeted for due to COVID-19.
