### Registration, Waivers and Crew Members

All entrants to the track, drivers and crew members, must register and sign the NNJR waiver. Registration will be set up in the paddock area. NNJR will issue color-coded wrist bands to drivers based on run group, with silver bands issued to all guests.

Registration will be the same hours as Tech Inspection.

Run groups, event schedules, track map, and work assignments are included.

#### **EVENT SPECIFIC INFORMATION**

#### Arrival at Track

Join us for Registration and a Welcome Social at the Finish Line Pub, from 4:30PM to 6:30PM, compliments of Paul Miller Porsche. The track becomes available to us at 7PM on Thursday, May 22<sup>nd</sup> for trailer drop off. Registration and Tech from 7PM - 8PM at the track.

#### Tech Inspections

**Note**: Prior to the event, all cars must complete a technical inspection at an authorized shop or dealer. Instructors may self tech. However, Instructors must submit proof of their annual professional tech inspection, which should be done at the beginning of the season.

All drivers are required to complete and sign the pre-tech inspection form and bring it to the track-side tech inspection. The form is available here:

There will be a tech inspection on Thursday night from 7:00 to 8:00. For those arriving on Friday morning, tech will begin at 7:00am and will complete by 8:00am. Anyone missing a tech session, or if you want a tech person to look at your car during the event, please see the tech steward and will be tech'd at the steward's convenience.

#### Noise Restrictions

No race cars or vehicles with unmuffled engines may be started prior to 8:30am or after 8:00pm.

#### Safety

NJ State motor vehicle regulations require full face helmets.

#### Food

The Finish Line Pub is open for lunch and dinner. They also have the Toast take-out app option for pick up at the Pub.

#### Fuel

Fuel, both race and street, will be available. NJMP's Tire & Tech Center powered by TK Autosports is now open. Located in the last Events Garages at Thunderbolt Raceway, the Center will service cars and motorcycles.

#### Car Numbers

You must provide numbers and apply them to your car prior to entering the tech line. Numbers do not need to be fancy: one inch blue painters masking tape works well on light colored cars. **Make sure you can read the number from 100' distance.** Door numbers should be at least six inches high and appear on both the driver and passenger side of the car. Front and rear numbers must be at least 4 inches high. This is a case where size does matter, bigger is better! **You must use the number assigned to you as shown in this track pack.** 

#### Attire

Long pants, preferably a natural fiber such as cotton, are required, as are closed-toed, rubber soled tie shoes. Short sleeves are allowed except at those tracks requiring long sleeves.

#### Bikes, Scooters, and Skateboards

These "vehicles" are not permitted in pit lane nor in the paddock where cars are entering or leaving the track or where tech inspection is being held. While permitted in other areas of the paddock, you are responsible to ensure that all proper safety gear is worn, in compliance with state law. Please inform anyone attending with you, especially children, to remain clear of prohibited areas and to exercise caution.

#### Paddock Jack Rules

Do NOT jack or place any jack stands on the asphalt. You must use wood or metal underneath any jack or jack stand.
